

Factsheet: Domiciliary Care Managers on the Register – 1 February 2017

Introduction

This information comes from the Social Care Wales Register of Social Care Workers.

Since 2014, domiciliary care managers must be qualified and registered with us.

Number of managers

There were **633** managers on the Register, an increase from 618 last year



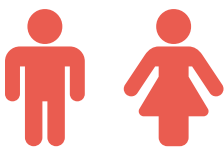
Turnover

87 managers left the Register and **102 joined** in the last year



Age & sex

There were **511 women** and **122 men**, and their average age was **49**



Employment sectors

59.7 % worked in the **private sector**, down 2.6%
25.9 % worked in the **third sector**, up 2.9%
13.8% worked in **local authority** social services, down 0.6%

Qualifications

All domiciliary care managers hold a relevant qualification, **29%** now hold the QCF Level 5 Diploma in Leadership for Health and Social Care Services (Adults' Management) **up 6%**



Years in job

47.7% of managers had been in their current job for more than five years, **down 7.6%** over the last four years



Welsh language

34.3% of managers spoke some **Welsh** or were fluent, **up 1.1%**
